

American Milking Shorthorn Junior Society

Australia Exchange Program

Application

Each candidate must be in good standing of their state Junior Milking Shorthorn Breeder's Association and/or an active junior member of the American Milking Shorthorn Junior Society for a minimum of two years. Active includes but is not limited to, entering in national or local competitions, attending meetings, attending conventions, and being involved in meetings and fundraising efforts.

Requirements:

1. Candidate must be single and between the ages of 18-21 as of January 1 the year in which they apply. This would include being able to attend during the year they turn 22.
2. Each candidate must enter an official entry blank, signed by his/her parent or guardian.
3. Each candidate is responsible for his or her own expenses in connection with the award.
4. Each candidate is required to sign a behavior contract. This contract will be reviewed prior to signing.
5. Recipient is required to attend the exchange 14 months after being presented the award or prior to the end of the year in which they turn 22. Whichever comes first. Preferably leaving in the months of June, July, or August.
6. The trip will be approximately 4-6 weeks in length but cannot exceed 8 weeks for any reason.
7. The AMSJS will compensate the awarded applicant \$1500.00 towards their airline transportation. Half will be compensated upon completion of your behavioral contract and half upon successful return to United States.
 - a. See financial contract for additional expectations.

Selection Process:

1. A committee of three or more judges will be selected by the junior advisor, junior president, and executive director. Examples of judges include: Board members, junior advisory members, local agricultural industry professionals, and extension employees.
2. All interviews are required to be held in conjunction with the National Milking Shorthorn Convention
3. Applicant must be present to interview.
4. Candidates are judged on maturity, personal appearance, general intelligence, public speaking ability, knowledge and experience with the general dairy industry and Milking Shorthorn breed.
5. Previous recipient of the exchange in good standing agreed upon by the Junior Advisory Committee.

Upon Selection:

1. Exchange recipient will be required to complete the following:
 - a. A daily journal of your activities
 - b. Photos to be shared via AMSJS Facebook page
 - c. Article summarizing your adventure to be published in "The Angle" and "The Yearbook". No later than October 1, 2021.
 - d. Prepare a photo album to be submitted to the AMSS to be on display at upcoming national shows and World Dairy Expo booth
 - i. If possible you are welcome to present the photos at the WDE booth
 - e. PowerPoint presentation at the following year annual convention

5. Detailed plan to carry out your exchange if chosen. Please include timeline.
 - a. Explain what you feel is needed to plan and execute this trip.

- Severe cases will result in termination of the trip and the participant will be required to return home at his/her own expense immediately
