Eligibility

National Contest and Award

Each year the application will be sent to Judging committee and each contestant will appear before three judges for twenty- minute interview at the National Convention. Then the winner will be awarded the Rachel Surridge Leadership Award at the annual awards banquet.

Material

The Application should be prepared carefully and neatly, typed in 12 font, double spaced, and present a true, easy-to-read story of contestant and registered Milking Shorthorns he or she owns and has developed. Material should be accurate, complete, and records submitted truly.
